**PowerPoint Requirements: (42 points)**

- ✗ Minimum of 15 slides
- ✗ Minimum of 6 pictures, must be relevant to topic
- ✗ First slide must be a title slide: your name, class name, name of country/culture
- ✗ Last slide must be a source slide: list all books and websites you used
- ✗ One slide must include fun facts about the country/culture

**Presentation Requirements: (20 points)**

- ✗ Must present PowerPoint to class
- ✗ Minimum of 7 minutes
- ✗ Need a handout or notes page for the class (given to me ahead of time to make copies)

**Source Requirements: (15 points)**

- ✗ Must use researched-based information
  - Any of the sources from the Electronic Resources page of the IKM-Manning homepage are great resources
  - CultureGrams: <http://online.culturegrams.com> (also book form in library)

- ✗ Include all sources on sources slide, even sources for pictures

- ✗ Need a minimum of 2 reliable sources

**Information Requirements: (60 points)**

- Introduction to the country/ culture you researched
  - Basic background information
  - Location, population, religious preferences, languages, etc.
  - Include a map showing location
- How does the culture use homes (what are they used for?)
  - What needs do homes fulfill? (social, private, cooking, gathering, etc.)
  - What is the difference between the man role and the woman role in the home?
  - Family: average size, are extended families common?
- Appearance
  - What do the average homes of the area look like? What are decorating styles?
    - Include information for both high end low end homes
    - Include information for both rural and urban homes
- Cost of homes
  - Include both high end and low end homes
  - Include both rural and urban homes
- Why did you choose to research this country/ culture?
- Compare and contrast the United States to the country/ culture you researched
  - Could include a Venn Diagram or chart on a slide
