Requirements:

- groups members will be responsible for collaborating to research and present the answer to the Driving Question above, including the content listed below
- give your project a title
- presentation must be interesting and well-researched
- all group members must participate in the research and presentation of topic
- you **MUST** keep track of all sources, Google is **NOT** a source

Content: (your group must find information on the following topics)

- fertilization
- prenatal development during each of the 9 months of pregnancy, the physical and emotional response for the baby and mother
- you must have a visual component to each of the 9 months of development, showing the length of the zygote/embryo/fetus at each stage
- end with labor and delivery, including the 3 stages of delivery
- define all vocabulary words as needed, if you don't know what it means then define it!

Sources:

- You **MUST** site all sources with the information
- Legally we have to give credit to where we get information!!!
- Google, Bing, Yahoo are NOT sources, they are search engines
