Create timeline (20 points)

- use your creativity to make your timeline
- must be 11x14 in size, or larger if need be
- construction paper, scissors, glue will be provided
- magazines are also available for pictures

Timeline entries (36 points)

- consider the significant family events that have taken place in your lifetime
- choose 1 important event for each year of your life
- you will have 16-18 entries, depending on how old you are
- you may need to talk to your parents or other adults (grandparents, aunts and uncles) in your life to discover events for each year

Pictures (18 points)

- pictures help explain events, you must include 1 picture for each entry
- pictures can come from magazines, the internet, be drawn, or be actual pictures
- timelines will be displayed, copies can be made of actual pictures

Summary (26 points)

- attach a summary on the back of your timeline, at least 1 page, typed, double-spaced
- talk about how the events of the timeline shaped your family, how your family handled the events, and the affects these events could have on your future family
- talk about what you learned about family or yourself from these events
- if you talked to a family member for information, talk about that in your summary
